Good things do come in small packages! Here is a first-rate treatment of the doctrine of justification along with some of its ramifications to the Christian life. The author, editor of Evangelical Times, correctly defines the concept, portrays it against the background of God's wrath, exalts the grace of God, and relates the doctrine to such things as assurance, depression, worship, false gospels, etc. Theological distinctions are nicely drawn, biblical passages carefully exegeted, and all communicated in a readable fashion.
