My question is this: Is pornography considered to be adultery or a form of adultery since Jesus speaks about looking on a woman to lust after her as having committed adultery in the heart? --Cheryl C.

Dear Cheryl: Certainly pornography and adultery are related. In Matthew 5:28, the Lord teaches that the lustful desire in one's heart of looking on a woman with lust can easily lead to the sinful act of adultery. Lusting can certainly be done whether the woman is in a picture or in the flesh.
