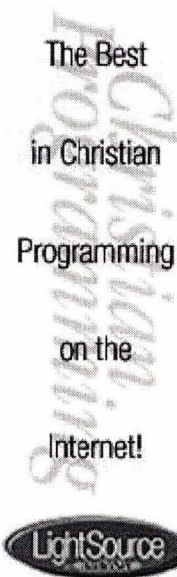

Subject: Is it OK to have sex if you are engaged?

Dear Dr. Ryrie: If you are saved and unmarried, can you have sex with a person you plan to marry in the future? --Yvonne

Dear Yvonne: Sex before marriage and sex outside of marriage are wrong. It is adultery, even if you plan to marry the person in the future, and the Bible clearly forbids this (Rom. 13:9). So if you are doing this now, break it off immediately and wait until you are married.
