a.He will therefore do what God does. Learn to distinguish the flesh--the Spirit b.He is God and therefore the same attribute will be manifest in us, in measure--. God is Light---We are light in the Lord. God is love----The love of God shed abroad God is righteous--He makes us righteous.

4. THE HOLY SPIRIT OCCUPIES THE BELIEVER FOR CHRIST. BOUGHT WITH A PRICE.
a.It is no longer I that live.
b.Christ is the owner of the life redeemed.
c.Illustration. The receipted bill had the mark of the Cross placed on it. It was crossed out. (Cf "Blotted out)

5. THE LOGICAL CONCLUSION OF THE ABOVE.
a.Glorify God in your body.
b.Glorify God in your soul.
c.Both are His.
