

PERSONAL WORK--MANNER AND METHOD.

Acts 20:19-20.

Emphasis must be placed on the worker.
We prepare the message--We should prepare the messenger equally well.

1. THE MANNER OF A PERSONAL WORKER.

- a. The calling of worker. "Serving the Lord"
He served the Lord not man.
This is the motive--if we would win souls.
God's great servants have had this motto:
"Whose I am and whom I serve".
- b. The humility of the worker. "All lowliness"
"My highest place is lying low
At my Redeemer's feet".
- c. The Earnestness of Worker. "With tears"
No soul birth without soul travail.
Service which costs nothing, will have no return. Boxer year and multiplied life.
- d. The endurance of the worker. "With trials"
Endurance is the evidence of calling.

2. THE METHOD OF THE CHRISTIAN WORKER.

- a. The world his parish. "To Jew and Greek"
Sympathies were wider than surroundings.
- b. He preached to profit of hearers. vs.20
He taught as well as testified.
- c. He preached in open meetings. "Publicly"
- d. He visited in homes & taught them. 20
- e. Paul preached in synagogues; prisons;
on shipboard, and in farewell meetings.
He preached to Many--To ones--Any place
was good for this preacher.

3. THE MESSAGE OF THE WORKER.

- a. The work is not complete, till the sinner meets the Savior. His message was:
Repentance towards God.
Faith in our Lord Jesus Christ.
