*.HIS MESSIAHSHIP SHOWED THE SIGNIFICANCE AND*THE VALUE OF HIS DEATH.

- a.As a propitiation for sins.
- b.Reconciliation of man and God.
- c.Redemption from all the ills of life.
 And eventual death.

4. THIS SALVATION—SECURED FOR EVERY MAN WHAT THE LAW COULD NOT OFFER.

- a.Law could not save from sin.
 - b.Christ's salvation accomplished what the law could not do.
 - c.It thus superseded the law.

- 5. THRU FAITH**WE ARE UNITED IN CLOSEST UNION WITH CHRIST.
 - a. Sharing His life in the Spirit.
 - b.Law is no longer necessary.
 - c.It had already proved its inefficiency in securing holy living.

6.THIS DISTINCTIVE CHARACTERISTIC OF JUDAISM WAS ABOLISHED. THEREFORE:-

- a. The distinction between Jew & Greek was gone b. The Gentile needed the Gospel as well as the Jew.
 - c.He was equally capable of exercising faith that secured it.
