2. they fed on the flock--did not feed them

3. they ruled with cruelty. vs. 4.

Diseased not strengthened..neither have

ye..neither have ye..neither have ye..

neither have ye..healed; bound; brought  
again; sought.

c. The pitiable plight of the flock. 5-6.

They were scattered and a prey. 5.

3. GOD WILL JUDGE THE EVIL SHEPHERDS. 17-21.

a. He will judge between cattle and eattle.

4. GOD'S SHEPHERD IS "MY SERVANT DAVID".22-31

a. I will save my flock. 23.

b. "One Shepherd..my servant David ".23.

c. "I the Lord will be their God..My Servant David a Prince among them". 24.

d. I will make a cov. of peace with them. 25

e. I will make them..a blessing. 25

f. Broken the bands of their yoke.26

g. No more a prey...shall dwell safely. 27  
and none shall make them afraid.

h. Messiah----the plant of Renown.

He is the "Rod" and "Branch" Isa.11:1.

He is the Righteous Branch. Jer. 23:5.

He is the one who shall for them obtain  
renown.
