God man predicted in Isa 7:14 Immanuel, not spirit but actual presence of viring born child. 9:6 born, given, Mighty God. El Gibbor (hero).

1. Predicted, Isa 7:14. almah. Marriagable virgin woman bethulah-virgin the not always. Tool 1.8 /Gen 24:43 bethulah-virgin tho not always, Joel 1:8. Who? Only to Mary, Mt 1:23. But what use to Ahaz? Someone in Isa's day and Mary. /l. Ahaz's wife. 2. unknown maiden in Is. Son unknown. 3. Isaiah's second wife to whom not yet married. Son was Maher (8:3). Shear (7:3) son of 1st wife who died. But clearly of Mary for parthenos means virgin. Only 1 virgin birth, Isa's wife didn't have a virgin birth.

III. Reason for virgin birth Journ conceptus 1854. Assumption 1450

Not nec to preserving X sinless. Sign of uniqueness of His person. Not widely known early (say, Pentecost), but by 50s-60s. considered crucial and est. early 2nd C. Gospels speak of parents, Lk 2:33,41, Matt 13:55. Incarnation new thing in universe; virgin birth was part and parcel of that.

IV. Genealogies. Matt is Joseph's, legal father and est. right to throne of David. Luke, Mary's . No art before Jos in 3:23. Matthan (Mt) and Matthat (Lk) same, making Jacob and Eli brothers. If Jacob died without heirs, then Jos would becomeheir tho nephew). Or Jacob died and Jer 22:30, 1 Chron 3:17-18 (adopted? Eli married widow. If blood descendant of Jos then X was desc of Coniah and cursed. Virgin birth freed Him from that. Or thru Nathan Lk 3:31. Or Zerubbabel Hag 2:23 (in both Mt, Lk), bec line thru which messianic promise fulfd. No one disputed X's claim to David.
