- C. In OT. Uncertain but Qal in Exod 3 means I am-Presence or eternality. In Ex 6, Hiphil-I create-power. Toggeher means Eternal Creator. Also meaning seen in acts of Exodus. Includes (1) gracious deliverance of nation and (2) sovereign control of nation.
