

WHAT IS THE GOSPEL?

Remember the warning in Galatians 1:8-9.

Does this include not only Judaizers who added circumcision to faith, but does it also warn those who add baptism, speaking in tongues, coming forward, repent and believe, “give your life to Christ,” etc?

Question #1: What Is Repentance?

It means to change your mind, but change it about what?

1. Non-saving repentance, Matt. 21:30; Heb. 12:17; Matt. 27:3.
2. Repentance in the Christian life to restore fellowship, Rev. 2:5 (singular) and 2:22 (plural), 3:3; 3:19.
3. Repentance unto salvation, 2 Pet. 3:9; Acts 17:30; Acts 2:38.

Question #2: In. What Ways Is Jesus Lord?

1. He is Lord of the Sabbath, Matt. 12:8.
2. He is Lord of His Day, Rev. 1:10.
3. He is Lord of His Supper, 1 Cor. 11:20
4. He is Lord of lords, Rev. 11:15.
5. He is Master over people, Luke 6:46
6. He is Lord=God, Acts 2:36; Rom. 10:9.

How does Jesus' lordship relate (1) to salvation and (2) to the Christian life?

Question #3: Can Born Again Believers Be Uncommitted?

See 2 Pet. 2:7; Acts 19:18-19.

Question #4: What Is the Direction of the Gospel?

Rom. 5:17; Eph. 2:8-9; Rom. 4:5.

Question #5: Is It Easy To Believe?

You ask people to trust Someone they have never seen.

You ask them to trust Him about eternal life.

You ask them to believe, not to work for eternal life.
