I. In relation to you, the Man, yourself.

- A. Your character, 1 Tim 3:1-7 you be blameless--no accusation brot husband 1 wife ever
 - vigilant--steady, calm
 - sober, sound minded
 - good behaviour, orderly, decent
 - hospitable
 - apt to teach--willing and able
 - no drunken violence
 - no striker--verbal or physical blows
 - not money mad
 - patient-sweet reasonableness
 - not brawler--no contention
 - not covetous--money lover
 - rule own house so church
 - tried--mature and maturing which we bel you are.
 - good testimony with world.
- B. Your conduct, 2 Tim 4:5
 - in sobriety--watch
 - in strictness--endure harass
 - in service--full all to which you are called.

II. In relation to your Message, 2 Tim 4:2-4

- A. Preach whole counsel of God. Don't ride hobby
- B. Be Prepared at all times. Be instant, stand pat in all opportunities.
- C. Preach to ^{all} needs to people. Reproof-show wrong; rebuke-show how wrong; exhort--show right. *in love = glorify God.*
- D. Preach with ^{all} assurance bec Rom 1:16. *authority.*
