  - 2. Jehovah's Witnesses. In Honduras 16 miss. 45 pd workers and 625 volunteers. In Sept 1961 made 5000 home calls. Most 1 hr calls of home Bible studies. In future plan to have 1 US trained teacher teach 25 nationals/month and they reach people.
- C. Communism. In every C.A. country it is officially outlawed and lit refused entrance. But clearly in evidence. They teach people whom miss consider unqualified for indigenous leadership.
- D. Nationalism. Miss will have to get out.
