- II. Its Facets
 - A. Historical
 - 1. Intervention in the affairs of heathen nations (e.g. Egypt, Jer. 46:10)
 - 2. Intervention in the affairs of Israel (Zeph. 1:14-18--invasion of Scythians' after death of Josiah).
 - B. Illustrative: an historical intervention which is a harbinger of the eschatological day of the Lord. Joel 2:1-11; Isa. 13:6-13
 - C. Eschatological
 - 1. Begins in midst of apparent peace, 1 Thess. 5:2.
 - Includes manifestation of man of sin, 2 Thess. 2:3-10.
 - 2. Includes trib. Jer. 30:7; Isa. 2:12-22; Rev. 6:12-17
 - 3. Includes coming of Christ, Joel 2:28-32
 - 4. Includes millennial blessing, Jer. 30:9; Isa. 19:23-25.
