Barth said no nat'l theol at all, Brunner said God does reveal self in creation now (1934-35 controvers: Leter resolved.

- I. Rev of God's Wrath, 1:18 Wrath=antagonism of holy love to evil. Revealed in what described in 24-32. Against all men who supress tath
- II. Reasons for God's Wrath, 19-23.
  - A. Bec. something is known bec rev has entered into minds and consciousnesses of men, 19. What known? eternal power (omnipotence and eternality) and Godhood-sum of divine attributes. —Supreme Being.

    How known? clearly seen. Further rebuke to man. Result? without excuse. Are heathen lost? Purpose? makes man responsible before God.
    - B. Bec man rejected when knew God. Result? idolatry. Rev in nature but Bible of nature does not save.
- III. Result of God's Wrath, 24-32. paredoken, 24,26,28. 3 viewpoints as to meaning
- Permissive giving over of men to fall into retributive consequences of their infidelity and apostasy.
   But active voice.
- 2. Privitative sense. God deprived man of as aspect of His work of common grace. Godet. God ceased to hold the boat being dragged by the current of sin.
- 3. Judicial sense. Positively gave men offer to jdgmt. Privitative sense included. Same as Acts 7:42. Identical form in Eph 4:19 which shows that man not coerced. God does not entice to sin. Sexual license as described in these vv. is the retributive judgment of God. bec of rejection of Gospel.
