A.D. Biography of Paul.

36. (?) Conversion.
37. (?) At Damascus.
38. (?) Flight from Damascus to Jerusalem, and thence to Tarsus.
39. (?) During these years St Paul preaches
40. (?) in Syria and Cilicia, making Tarsus
41. (?) his headquarters, and probably under goes most of the sufferings mentioned at 2 Cor. 11:24-26, viz. two of
42. (?) the Roman, and the five Jewish
43. (?) scourgings, and three shipwrecks. (The five Jewish scourgings and two of the three Roman beatings with rods (one at Philippi) and the three shipwrecks are all unrecorded in the Acts.)
44. Brought from Tarsus to Antioch Acts 11:2 Stays there a year before the famine.
45. Visits Jerus. with Barnabas to relieve the famine.
46. Antioch. Also 47
48. First Missy. Journey. Antioch, Cyprus, Antioch in Pisidia, Iconium, Lystra, and Derbe.
49. Back through the above mentioned places.
50. Paul & Barnabas attend Council in Jerus.
51. Second Missy Journey. Antioch to Cilicia, Lycaonia, Galatia.
- 52* Troas, Philippi, Thessalonica, Berea, Athens and Corinth. Writes 1 Thess.
- 53* At Corinth. Writes 2 Thess.
54. (Spring) He leaves Corinth and reaches (Summer) Jerusalem at Pentecost, and thence goes to Antioch. (Autumn) Third Missy. Journey. Antioch.
- 55.56. At Ephesus.

- 57* (Spring) He writes 1 Corinthians.
 (Summer) Leaves Ephesus for Macedonia.
 * (Autumn) Writes 2 Cor. in Macedonia.
 (Winter) and thence to Corinth where
 * he Wrote Galatians.
- 58* (Spring) Wrote Romans and leaves Corinth
 going by way of Philippi, and Miletus.
 (Summer) To Jerusalem at Pentecost,
 where he is arrested and sent to Cesarea
- 59.. At Cesarea.
60. (Autumn) sent to Rome by Festus about
 August. (Winter) shipwrecked at Malta.
61. (Spring) He arrives in Rome.
- 62* At Rome. Writes Philemon, Colossians,
Ephesians; (Spring). Philippians (Autumn)
63. (Spring) He is acquitted, and goes to
 Macedonia. Phil. 2:24, and Asia Minor,
 Philem. 22.
64. (?) He goes to Spain. The remarks on
 65. this are hypothetical, and unsupported
 66. by fact, although the case is well
 argued in Conybeare
- 67* (Summer) Wrote 1 Tim. from Macedonia
 (Autumn) Wrote Titus from Ephesus.
 (Winter) At Nicopolis.
- 68* (Spring) In prison at Rome. Wrote 2 Tim.
 (Summer) Executed. (May or June)
