Is it wrong to sometimes question things like creation, the second coming of Christ and so on? Should we just accept such things on faith or should we search for answers to our doubts?

Well, I think the answer to that question is both. There are some things we have to accept on faith but, of course, God does not want us to put our brains on the shelf when we become a Christian. He also wants us to think and search things out. It's true there are some things which are past finding out. We can never get the answers to some things. If that's the case and God says something about it then we'll have to accept such things on faith. Now, specifically, we can investigate things about the creation and opposing explanations to the creation account in the Bible. We can investigate the claims of evolution and see if these things make sense or not. We ought to put our minds to these things because there is a rational and reasonable answer. Peter tells us to be able and ready to give an answer for the hope that's in us. So, don't put your mind in neutral and feel that because you're a Christian you can't investigate anything. You should investigate. God will, I'm sure, show you the right answer. On the other/hand, something like the second coming which is yet future, there is no way to investigate that except that God says that Jesus Christ will return to this earth and apparently He will, actually He will, truthfully He will because God says so. And yet even that is subject to some confirmation by our minds. After all, there were lots of promises about the first coming of Jesus Christ, more than 300 of them, and we can investigate those and when we do we can find out that they were all fulfilled just exactly as they were promised. Now my mind tells me that if God fulfills those promises exactly as He said, Then He'll surely fulfill the promises about the second coming of Christ exactly as He said. Even though the second coming is future and in a sense I have to accept it by faith, I can confirm my faith in that by the simple fact that I look back at the first coming of Jesus Christ and all those promises and I realize that God did it just as he's promised. And so, I can expect God, I can trust God, I can believe that God will do all that is future in exactly the same way, just as he's promised. So the answer to your question is khark both things, there are some things you take by faith, on the other hand you need to investigate everything because God expects us to. He has given us minds and He wants us to Glorify God in our mind as well.
